Beyond the Basics

Two additional seminars are being introduced this year for parents, caregivers, day care workers, educational assistants, teachers, resource teachers, and other professionals. Beyond the Basics takes an in-depth look at some of the common challenges that are faced by people who have Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Topics chosen this year include:

Toileting Challenges — Is the child ready? Where do we start? What if its not working? How can we develop a program that works? A variety of strategies will be discussed

Sensory Strategies for Daily Living — an in-depth exploration of various sensory tools and strategies that target some of the most challenging daily activities (eating, sleeping, dressing, bathing, hygiene, and other daily activities)



Communication Technology — staff from Open Access Resource Centre will present important information that should be considered before introducing a communication device—when to introduce a device, how to start, which one to choose, specifically looking at the iPod, iPad, and “Say it Sam” as communication devices

Building Connections — this session will provide essential information for adults who live and work with children with Autism Spectrum Disorder to become effective guides for their children. Session participants will learn ways to guide children to experience meaningful connections in their exploration and participation in the social world
